DOME VICTORY IN THE FACE OF UTTER DEVASTATION

Try to imagine yourself being at the top of your chosen vocation. You plan and prepare to enter into one of the top iterations of that vocation. For weeks you work hard and feel like you have put yourself in the best possible position to be successful. You also enter knowing that this will be one of the most physically and mentally challenging iterations you will be in. Now imagine that just as you are about to apply all that you have prepared for, you are dealt the most devastating circumstance that you ever think of. What would you do? How would you respond? Would you stick your head in the sand and choose to not participate? Would you let every-



one involved know of your circumstance and hope for their pity? Or would you tighten your belt up and go out and get what you came for?

If you are 2022 Castrol Gateway Dirt Nationals Late Model champion Tyler Erb, the only option conceivable is the latter. Just four days before Erb drove his Best Performance Motorsports ride into Victory Lane on the floor of the Dome at America's Center that devastating circumstance became his reality. His father Mark, who had traveled with the team to St. Louis for the event, suddenly fell ill and succumbed to a heart attack. Erb, his family and team decided it was best for them to remain in St. Louis and compete. They also elected not to tell anyone what had happened.

Erb, a high-profile and hardnosed Dirt Late Model driver from Texas, at the age of 25 had already faced his share of adversity in his short lifetime. At seven years old Erb was diagnosed with Ewing's Sarcoma a type of cancer which attacks the bones and soft tissue. Erb was able to beat the cancer through chemotherapy and radiation treatments. His illness led Erb to Eldora Speedway as a Make-A-Wish Kid. That encounter eventually led to his all-out to go --- racing. Erb was a bit rough and unpolished when he first entered the national stage of Dirt Late Model racing. Many of his clashes with his competitors in his





early career resulted in lots of bent sheet metal and plenty of ill will.

In recent years Erb has become a more polished and skilled racer, attracting many fans across the country as he competes with the Lucas Oil Late Model Dirt Series. Granted Erb can still get elbows up and trade paint when he needs to. So, the Castrol Gateway Dirt Nationals are firmly within his wheelhouse. The tight confines of the 1/5th mile temporary track typically favor drivers with a more aggressive style of driving. This race track is both physically and mentally demanding. Though you have to be aggressive, you must also be precise and deliberate to be successful. There is a razor's

edge between making a winning pass or just stuffing it in the wall.

The amount of focus and mental fortitude needed to run 40 laps around this track is immense. Just putting yourself in position to win the highly sought after St. Louis Gateway Arch trophy along with the \$30,000 winner's prize takes a lot of guts, poise and even a little bit of luck. So, the mental toughness needed to win this event while submersed in his anguish and turmoil is both incredible and completely unfathom-

able to most observers.

Erb's victory seemed highly unlikely as the laps began to wane with young Georgia racer Wil Herrington comfortably in control as the leader with nearly a 2 second lead. But the field slowed beneath a yellow flag with just seven laps remaining. The subsequent restart saw Erb make a daring move splitting his foes Herrington and Tanner English to take over the lead. Another yellow for Herrington on the 35th circuit set up a final showdown between Erb and English. But Erb was able to fight off English over the final 5 laps to get the victory.

Once he had pulled off the victory, Erb amid the adulation and cheers of the massive

crowd, chose his Victory Lane interview to share the news with everyone. "All of our family and everybody close to us is watching this, so it would just be easier for me to say it once and be done," said Erb, as his voice began to crack. "But my dad, who is my best friend in the whole world, we got to St Louis and he had a heart attack Wednesday and died. And I'm sorry to my friends and everybody this week. I haven't said anything because it's just tough you know. I apologize to all my friends and everybody, but I've just been dealing with a lot trying to keep to myself.

"We just decided ... I just decided it would be better to stay here and support my mom. I love her with all my heart and I always will. Don't think this is a sob story. Man, this is the worst news I could ever have thought of in my whole life, but I just put in the back of my mind and raced and got it done. So, I guess he was definitely helping us this week. You know, we'll just have to take life every day from here on out."

As Erb's words freshly hung in the air, the arena fell silent. Everyone present was seemingly stunned. Then a resounding cheer in support of Erb



and his mother who had joined him in Victory Lane. But the shock everyone was feeling was evident. In fact, the FloRacing stream broadcast team of Ben Shelton and Dustin Jarrett were so affected they had to cut to a commercial after Victory Lane wrapped up to gather themselves. Both had a personal connection with Erb and both were equally taken aback by the news.

"The range of emotions that night was perhaps unlike anything I've ever experienced at a race and really in my life in general. Here you had Tyler Erb, who had ended the year with some struggles behind the wheel, rolling into the Dome and




for him to end the year, and then suddenly the air was sucked out of the room, when he revealed the devastating news that his father had passed away a few days earlier upon their arrival in St. Louis. When I began my career in motorsports 15 years ago, the Erb family were some of the first people to support me. Since then, they've become like family, and it was a complete gut punch when Tyler revealed the news about Mark." Shelton lamented.

Jarrett added, "As announcers, we're fortunate to become friends with a lot of these drivers and their families outside the track. Knowing Tyler well, I thought he was showing an unusual amount of emotion in victory lane. And then when he mentioned his dad had passed, I was simply overcome by the raw emotion of the moment. I looked over and saw Ben tearing up. I thought I could take over the broadcast. I thought wrong." It was indeed the worst kind of gut punch which blindsided everyone in that moment.

Veteran Dirt Racing Reporter Kevin Kovac was similarly shocked but Erb's revelation. "I saw Tyler in the pits, and talked to him, a couple times earlier in the weekend, and I didn't sense anything that would have led me to believe he was racing under such difficult circumstances. So, when he let his emotions out in victory lane and then told the crowd that his father had died just days earlier, I was shocked — just like everyone else.

"Then when I got to talk with Tyler alongside his car in the pits after his win — before the rush of fans made their way in there — he was still remarkably calm and clear-headed after going through such a rush of emotions. He spoke about how seeing his mother in victory lane was what made him tear up, and then he went on to give me probably one of the deepest and most emotional interviews I've ever done with a race car driver. What struck me the most was how he spoke about his mother — everyone knows Tyler is a jokester and likes to ham it up, but he was dead serious explaining how all he was thinking about all weekend was what his mother needed to get her through the loss of her husband. Tyler grew up that week — even he admitted that."

It was no secret that by his own standards Erb had a down year. Then to suffer such a great loss seemingly could have been a knockout blow. But out of the tragedy, Erb was able to find the triumph. And in the process another storied moment was added to the many unforgettable moments that have previously taken center stage at the Castrol Gateway Dirt Nationals.


